How has God used Grace Fellowship Church to impact your life?


Read Joshua 4: 1–9. God has just miraculously parted the Jordan River allowing the Israelites to cross against all odds. What stands out to you about God's instructions to the Israelites? Why is remembering what God has done in the past so important to our faith?

From what you have heard and seen during our 40year anniversary celebration, which part of Grace's history inspires you the most? What do you hope future generations hold onto as we step boldly into the future? Are you willing to commit to being part of that?



In Joshua 4, God instructs the Israelites to make a memorial of stones to mark the moment when He miraculously parted the Jordan River. The story of God's faithfulness in delivering the Israelites into the Promised Land would be passed down from generation to generation. In the same way, we need to mark moments in our own lives and tell the story of when God moves mountains for us.
