Matthew 25:14 - 30



DISCUSS IT

In one apple, God places the potential for unlimited exponential expansion. What other examples of exponential expansion do you see in the world around you?

Read Matthew 25:14 – 30. Imagine yourself as each of the three servants. How do you think each servant felt when the master returned and addressed their stewardship of what had been entrusted to them? In your mind, what is the difference between an owner and a manager?

Kingdom expansion involves taking risks and trusting that God will be faithful. Share a time when you stepped out in faith and took a risk. What did you learn from that experience about yourself and about God? If you haven't, what is stopping you?

Reflect on what you've learned. Then, write and/or draw your thoughts below.

Spend a few minutes drawing (or listing) the gifts, talents, treasures, and resources God has entrusted to you.
